- * December imports of goods (\$216.4 billion) were the highest since October 2018 (\$217.2 billion).
- * December imports of capital goods (\$58.9 billion) were the highest since December 2018 (\$59.2 billion).
- December imports of automotive vehicles, parts, and engines (\$33.1 billion) were the highest on record.
- * December non-petroleum imports (\$205.9 billion) were the highest on record.

Real Dollar Basis (Chained 2012 Dollars, seasonally adjusted)

* December real dollar imports of goods (\$243.2 billion) were the highest on record.
