


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Metropolitan Area, 2017

- Real GDP increased in 27 of the 38 MSAs wholly contained in this region. Growth in real GDP ranged from 3.7 percent to –6.6 percent.
- New York-Newark-Jersey City, NY-NJ-PA—the largest metropolitan area in the region, and the largest in the nation—increased 1.3 percent due to growth in professional and business services. Philadelphia-Camden-Wilmington, PA-NJ-DE-MD—the 2nd largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 8th largest in the nation—increased 1.4 percent due to growth in professional and business services.
- Per capita real GDP in the MSAs wholly contained in this region ranged from \$71,084 in New York-Newark-Jersey City, NY-NJ-PA to \$27,735 in Johnstown, PA.
