


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Metropolitan Area, 2017

- Real GDP increased in 20 of the 22 MSAs wholly contained in this region. Growth in real GDP ranged from 9.4 percent to –2.5 percent.
- Denver-Aurora-Lakewood, CO—the largest metropolitan area in the region, and 18th largest in the nation—increased 3.6 percent due to growth in professional and business services.
 Salt Lake City, UT—the 2nd largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 41st largest in the nation—increased 2.5 percent due to growth in professional and business services.
- Per capita real GDP in the MSAs wholly contained in this region ranged from \$70,077 in Boulder, CO to \$27,237 in Pueblo, CO.
