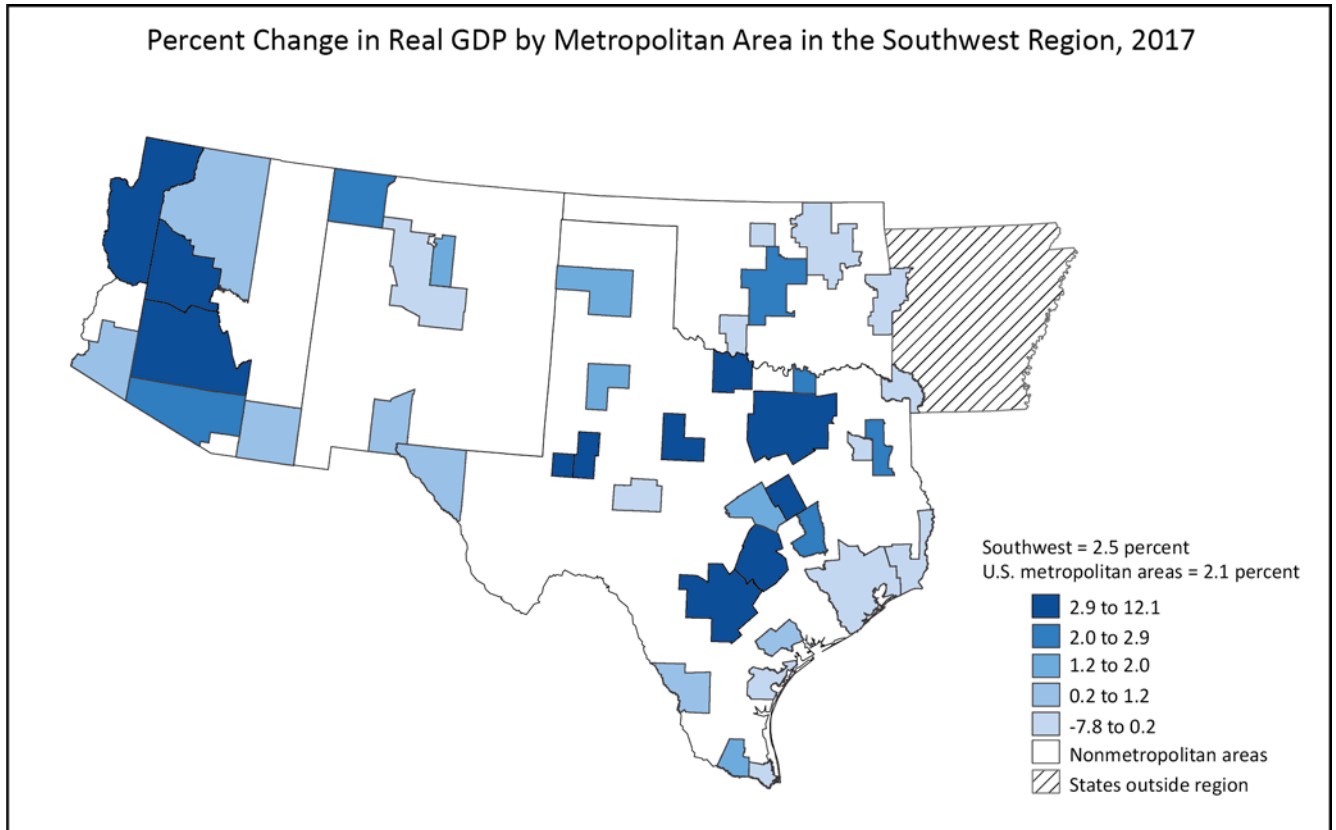


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Metropolitan Area, 2017

- Real GDP increased in 30 of the 39 MSAs wholly contained in this region. Growth in real GDP ranged from 12.1 percent to -7.8 percent.
- Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington, TX—the largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 4th largest in the nation—increased 3.9 percent due to growth in finance, insurance, real estate, rental, and leasing. Houston-The Woodlands-Sugar Land, TX—the 2nd largest in the region, and 7th largest in the nation—had no change in growth.
- Per capita real GDP in the MSAs wholly contained in this region ranged from \$174,749 in Midland, TX to \$18,142 in Lake Havasu City-Kingman, AZ.
